At the Squadron meeting on June 6, the members voted to spend up to \$100 for door prizes at the golf tournament.

I attended the Maryland American Legion Riders Legacy Scholarship Run dinner in La Plata on June 10. After dinner, donations were presented. I was pleased to present a check for \$1,000 on behalf of the Squadron 82.

The Squadron held a Flag Retirement ceremony on Flag Day. A small group of members and friends watched as 300 flags were honorably retired. We still have quite a few flags to retire, so we will hold another Flag Retirement ceremony in the fall.

The Squadron sponsored another successful Baby Back Rib dinner on June 16. One Hundred and twenty-seven dinners were served, including ten residents and three staff members from the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home, guests of the Post 82 family for the evening.

On June 19, Gale Willett and Gary Shupe worked the floor at the Southern Maryland Region bingo at the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home. Thirty-five residents attended and \$200 in prizes were given out directly to the winners.

The 17th Annual Joe Williams Memorial Golf Tournament, sponsored by the Harry White Wilmer American Legion Post 82 and the Sons of The American Legion Squadron 82 was held at the White Plains Golf Course on June 23, 2023. Thirty-four teams comprised of 133 golfers participated. The weather started out threatening, but the rain held off until later in the day.

Following the golf tournament, Gary Shupe and I went to Hunt Valley for the Detachment of Maryland 50th Annual Convention at the Delta Marriott Hotel on June 24-25. At the Saturday business session, the Squadron was presented several Certificates of Appreciation, including "outstanding efforts and support of" the American Legion National Emergency Fund (NEF), Veterans Affairs Voluntary Service (VAVS) Commission, Child Welfare Fund (CWF), Children's Miracle Network (CMN), Casey Cares Foundation, Boys State, and Charlotte Hall Veterans Home. Commander Tatman was proud and honored to receive the John S, Tingle, Sr., Memorial Award as the Maryland VAVS Volunteer of the Year.

The latest scoop from the Steel Pony Corral:

On Saturday June 3, Director Jamie Z led a ride to Towson Post 22 for the North Central Region S.A.L. Commanders Ride. Joining riders from all around Maryland at Post 22, we rode to American Legion Post 182 in Whiteford, ending at Post 47 in Havre de Grace. After some refreshments we were back on the road for home, 268 miles round trip with just gorgeous weather.

On Thursday June 8, 5 Riders from ALR 82 attended the MD Gold Star Legacy Ride kick-off dinner hosted by Post 11 Frederick MD. We were joined the next morning by 8 more Riders and 3 passengers as we joined Riders from most of the ALR Chapters in the state. Over the next 3 days we rode from Central MD to Western MD and then down to Southern MD before finishing on Sunday in Annapolis MD where we laid a wreath at The Gold Star Family Memorial. The goal to raise 100K for the American Legion Legacy Scholarship Fund was greatly exceeded! Riders from all over MD raised upwards of 192K on the weekend which is expected to go over 200K when the final tally is complete.

On Saturday afternoon about 98 Riders rolled into La Plata via Charles St with Post 82 members waving American flags in a great welcome! Post 82 Riders hosted dinner that evening at the Holiday Inn Express La Plata.

A grand time was had by all with a delicious meal donated by Texas Roadhouse of La Plata and use off the banquet room by Holiday Inn Express. Please show these two businesses some love when eating out or having out-of-town guest's stayover.

Huge "Thanks" to Mayor Jeannine James for her continued support. The Town of La Plata Police Department and the Charles County Sheriff's Office were fantastic providing us an escort to the county line. This huge undertaking, with so many bikes and support vehicles, was completed safely and orderly.

On Thursday, June 15, 5 Riders rode the Northern Neck to Kilmarnock VA. where the group toured, the Kilmarnock Museum and had a great lunch at Lee's Restaurant.

On Saturday June 17, the Riders from Post 82 and Post 259 joined with Rolling Thunder 1 and the Combat Veterans of America to perform an escort mission taking Army Captain Korey Platt to his final resting place in The Gates of Heaven Cemetery Silver Spring, MD.
